The course is specially going to focus on how pop culture influences the perceptions of Japanese society and identity, taking as basis for the analysis approaches from marketing studies, gender studies and so on. As examples of pop culture, we will be analyzing movies, music, TV programs, karaoke, fashion, manga and anime.
